Abstract

The objectives of this research were to study the opinions of citizens about the garbage handling of the office of Yannawa District, Bangkok, and to compare the opinions of local citizens in this regard by dividing individuals into different categories such as sex, age, educational level, profession, monthly income and residential area. The information was collected by random sampling for the family leaders of 22 communities in Yannawa District. The apparatus used was a questionnaire. The language used in the questionnaire was approved by the thesis advisors and distinguished individuals. The reliability was found to be 0.8952. The statistical analysis used in percentage, standard deviation and t-test.

The research results indicated that majority of the respondents were male, below associates degree in education and with incomes of between 5,001-10,000 baht per month. Their opinions concerning the management of garbage handling on moving of the garbage and public relations were at a moderate level. But the opinions about the charging of the fee was at a high level. The testing of hypotheses revealed that the respondents with different levels of education, gender, occupation, types of residence and income had varying opinions on management of the garbage at an .001 level of significance. However, age of the respondents did not affect opinions on management of the garbage by Yannawa District Office.
