

Thesis Title : Motivation to Perform Duties of Primary School Teachers in Private Schools
in Bangkok Educational Service Area Office 3

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Abstract

This research purposes were: (1) to study levels of motivation to perform duties of Primary School Teachers in Private Schools in Bangkok Educational Service Area Office 3 . (2) to compare the levels of motivation to perform duties of primary school teachers in private schools in Bangkok Educational Service Area Office 3 by categorizing demographic data such as sex, marital status, age, experience in teaching, salary and education level. Another factor was the sizes of schools. The sample were 333 teachers in private primary schools in Bangkok Educational Service Area Office 3 . Research tool was a questionnaire consisting of two parts. Part 1 was checklist asked about status of the sample. Part 2 was rating scale asked about motivation to perform duties of teachers in private primary schools. Data were analyzed by percentage, means, and standard deviation. Hypotheses were tested by t-test and ANOVA.

Research results found that (1) Level of motivation of teachers in private primary schools were high. (2) Comparing motivation to perform duties of teachers in private primary schools in Bangkok Educational Service Area Office 3 with independent variables, it was found that factors on demographic data such as sex, age, marital status, experience in teaching, salary, education level and different sizes of schools were not significantly difference at statistical level in motivation to perform duties.
