

Independent study title: Opinions of the prisoners on the administration procedures of the corrections officer in the Nonthaburi Province.



Abstract

The objectives of this research were to: 1) to study the opinions of prisoners of the administrative procedures of correctional service officers in the Nonthaburi Provincial Prison. 2) to compare the opinions of prisoners based on personal characteristics. The sample was 335 prisoners in the prison of Nonthaburi Province. Questionnaires were used as a research tool, reliability 0.7359. Data were analyzed by frequency, percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, and analysis of variance.

The results of the research indicated that 1) the mean score, overall, of opinions held by the prisoners of the administrative procedures of correctional service officers was at the medium level. When considering each aspect on the questionnaires it was found that for the classification procedures the officers had the knowledge and experience to classify prisoners and the officers were good public servants. Education, mental and moral development training was offered by officers following the prisoners placemat. Vocational training, the training program was based on the department of corrective services regulations. Probation practices, probation practices were explained clearly by officers to the benefit of the probationary prisoners. 2) Comparison of the mean score of the opinions of prisoners of the administration of correctional officers found that prisoners with different marital status and education level had different opinions statistically significant at 0.01. When considered by each aspect it was found that the officers of the prisoner classification division where a prisoner's history was studied, were able to classify the prisoners appropriately, the officers in vocational training diversion advised suitable vocations to prisoners, the officers of probation practices division were the best regarded by prisoners.

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
