

Term Paper Title Factors Associated with the Stress of the Students of the
Department of General Education at Prarajchawangderm Campus
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ABSTRACT

This term paper aimed to explore (1) the stress level and (2) the relationship between the stress level and related factors of the secondary school students under the Department of General Education at Prarajchawangderm Campus. Such factors included sex, academic standing, academic year, health problem, academic personality, manner and parents' expectation.

The population were 341 students of the secondary school under the supervision of the Department of General Education at Prarajchawangderm Campus. There were two types of questionnaires. The first one was about stress related factors consisting of 3 parts: (1) general information, (2) academic personality and (3) manner. The second one was Dougan's stress test questionnaire. The statistic used was percentage, mean (\bar{x}), standard deviation (SD) and chi square.

The results revealed that 50.7% of the students had the average stress level. The stress level was related to academic year and academic personality at the level of significance 0.05. On the other hand, the stress level was not related to sex, personal disease, parents' expectation, academic standing and manner.
